



BOCCONI CONVERSATIONS IN INTERNATIONAL LAW

THE ARTICULATION AND ENFORCEMENT OF OBLIGATIONS *ERGA OMNES*: RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

As seen in the ongoing cases of *The Gambia v. Myanmar*, *Canada and The Netherlands v. Syria* and *South Africa v. Israel*, the characterisation of certain international obligations as obligations erga omnes or more precisely, in the context of multilateral treaty obligations, erga omnes partes has in recent years supported the enforcement of these obligations through the institution of contentious proceedings before the International Court of Justice by states other than injured states. Not only has this thrown up new procedural challenges for the Court. It has also raised the question of how obligations erga omnes are to be identified.

The event will focus on recent developments in the articulation and enforcement of obligations erga omnes under international law.
